1. Position Title: Assistant Professor (1 position)
2. Affiliation: Department of Physics
3. Research Field and Job Description:
  - Research in experimental particle physics, especially in collider experiments and neutrino experiments, in collaboration with Prof. Masahiro Kuze.
  - Research support for group members. • Graduate and undergraduate education.
  - Administrative activities.
4. Start of Employment: Commencing on 1 April 2018 is expected.
5. Period of Employment: A maximum 5-year term (a reappointment not exceeding five years may be possible after review)
6. Requirements: Applicants are required to have a Ph.D or Doctoral degree in an area related to the above research field.
7. Salary: An annual salary will be paid according to the National University Corporation Tokyo Institute of Technology Regulations on Wage and Salary for Staff on the Annual Salary System.
8. Documents for the Application:
  - (1) A Curriculum Vitae with applicant's photograph, e-mail and postal addresses, including professional career records and doctoral degree.
  - (2) List of publications and conference presentations, including awards and grants, if any.
  - (3) Statement of research achievements (up to 3 pages in A4 format).
  - (4) Statement of research and teaching plans, including the possible date to start (up to 2 pages in A4 format).
  - (5) Contact address (name, affiliation, and e-mail address) of up to three references.
  - (6) PDF files of significant papers (no more than three papers).
  - (7) One recommendation or reference letter. The author of this letter should be included in the three references in (5).
